- Install all electrical in the new trap houses - completed
- Cut lumber for flooring and both floors laid - completed
- Remove all useable items/parts from old trap houses 4 & 5 - completed

Week of 8/14/17

- Spray paint outside of new trap houses - completed
- Clean & paint trap house 1, 2 & 3 – completed
- Remove all useable items/parts from old trap houses 4 & 5 - completed
- Prepare trap 1 for footings & walls – completed
- Prepare conduit & wiring underneath new sidewalk

Week of 8/21/17

- Demolish old trap house 4 & 5
- Install new trap house 4 & 5
- Landscaping around the trap houses
- Seed grass
- Concrete work to be completed on sidewalk, trap shooting pad & pistol range shooting pad

Week of 8/28/17

- Install new fence between sidewalk & trap range
- Final landscaping
- Install & complete new wiring on all 4 easy pull posts
- Final coat of paint on trap 4 & 5

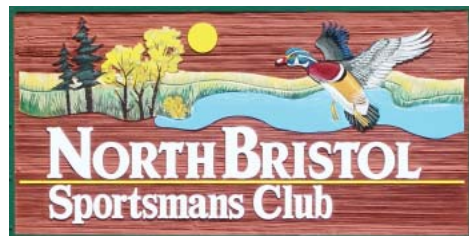
